

Exploration and Creator Summer Learning Experiences



**For kids who love to explore, make, and share,
this program is for you!**

Over two weeks, students will engage in a variety of projects in science/technology, visual arts and cooking. The literacy and numeracy connections within each project will be highlighted and made visible to the students in order to deepen their understanding.

Who: Students who will be entering Grades 7 and 8 in September 2019 can enroll.

Where: There are three sites to choose from: Cardinal Newman Catholic Secondary School, Cathedral High School, and St. Thomas More Catholic Secondary School.

Session Dates and Times: There are two learning experiences available. Both the Exploration and Creator Learning Experiences run simultaneously.

Session 1: Exploration or Creator Learning Experience Monday July 8 – Friday July 19, 2019 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.	Session 2: Exploration or Creator-Learning Experience Monday August 12 – Friday August 23, 2019 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.
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Cost: There is no cost for students.

The learning session includes: All materials needed for the projects.

Explorations and Creator topics: Both Session 1 and Session 2 will cover the same topics, however students can register for either session or both sessions if they wish. The topics are:

Exploration Learning Experience - Students entering grade 7 in 2019

Coding	Students will use coding to solve problems and navigate around obstacles.
Building	Students will work along with a building expert to design and build a small project with the use of simple tools.

Creator Learning Experience – Students entering grade 8 in 2019

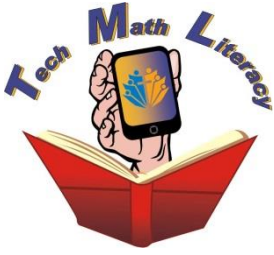
Science/Technology	Students will design and create a variety of items, including a roller coasters and catapults, to test scientific theories.
Art	Students will create a number of works of art.
Cooking	Students will create menus and learn to cook a variety of delicious snacks. Students will have the opportunity to eat what they make.
